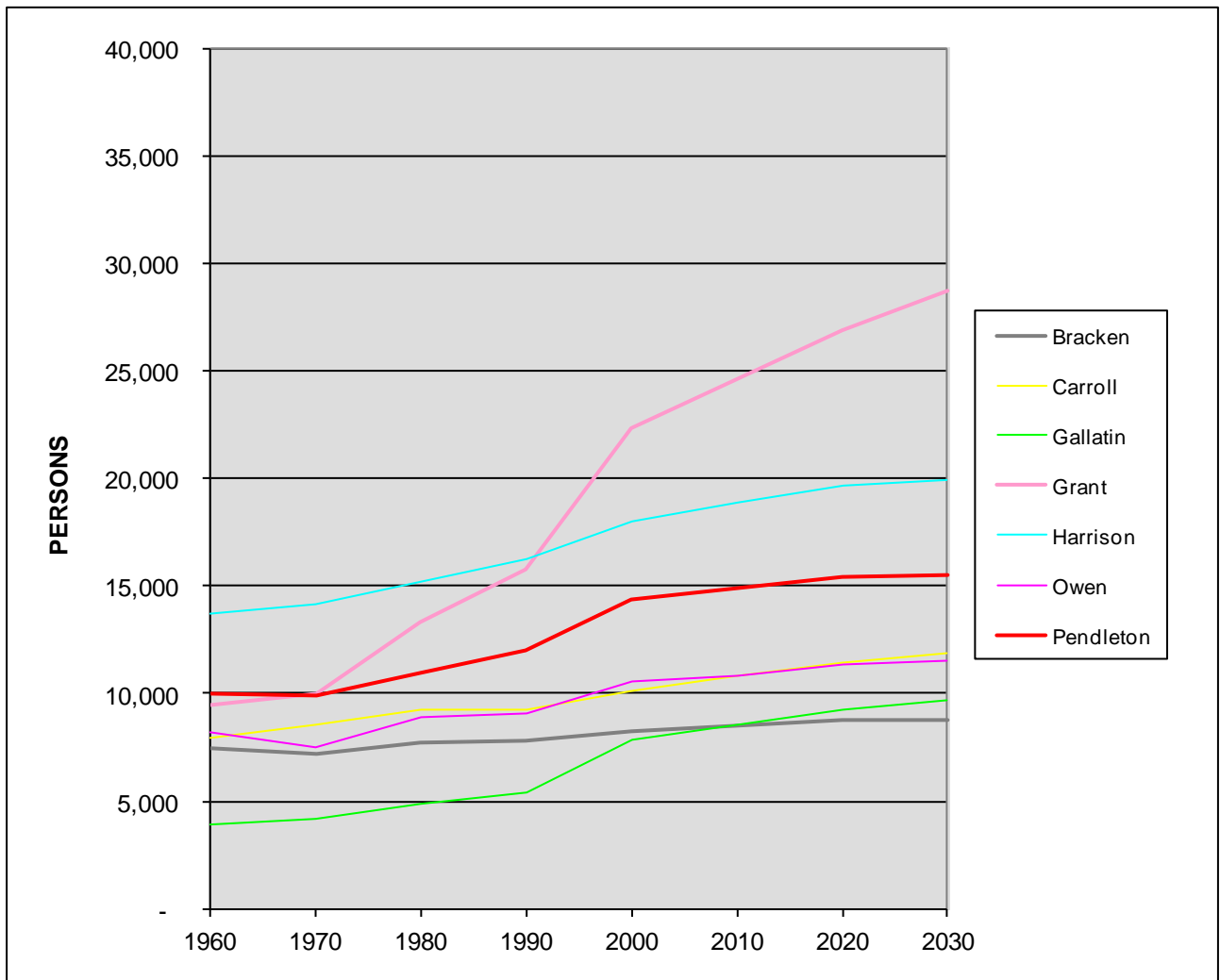

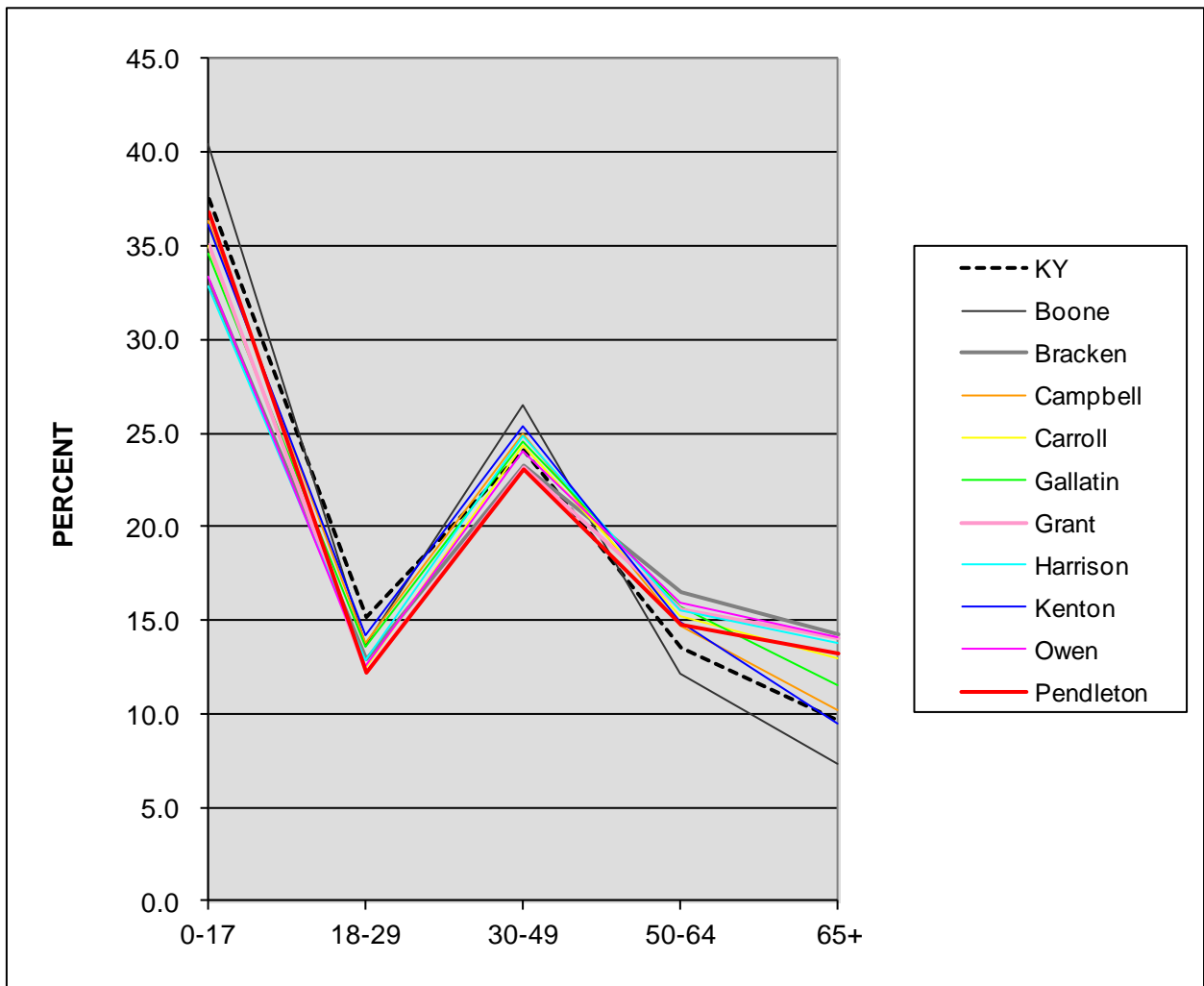

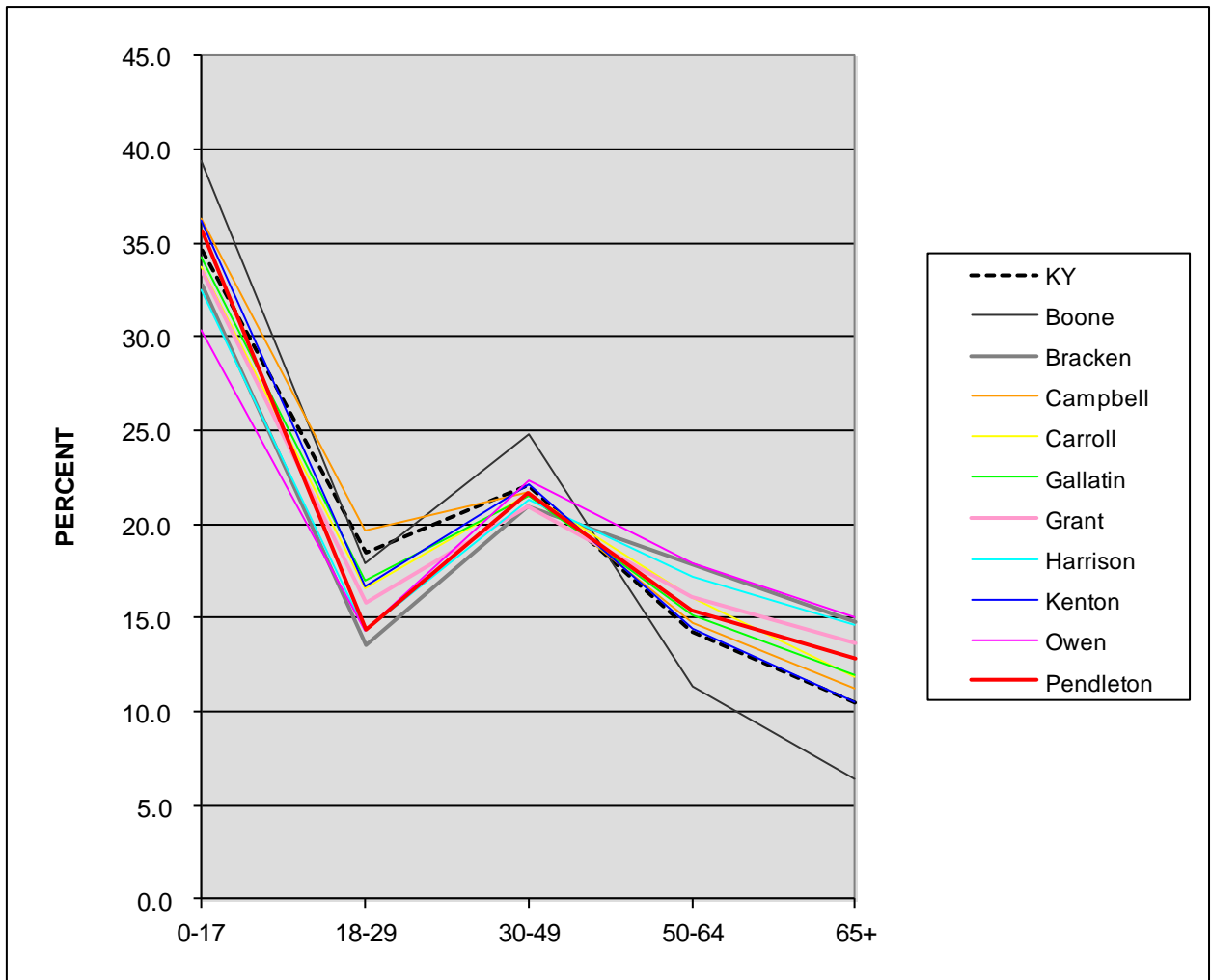

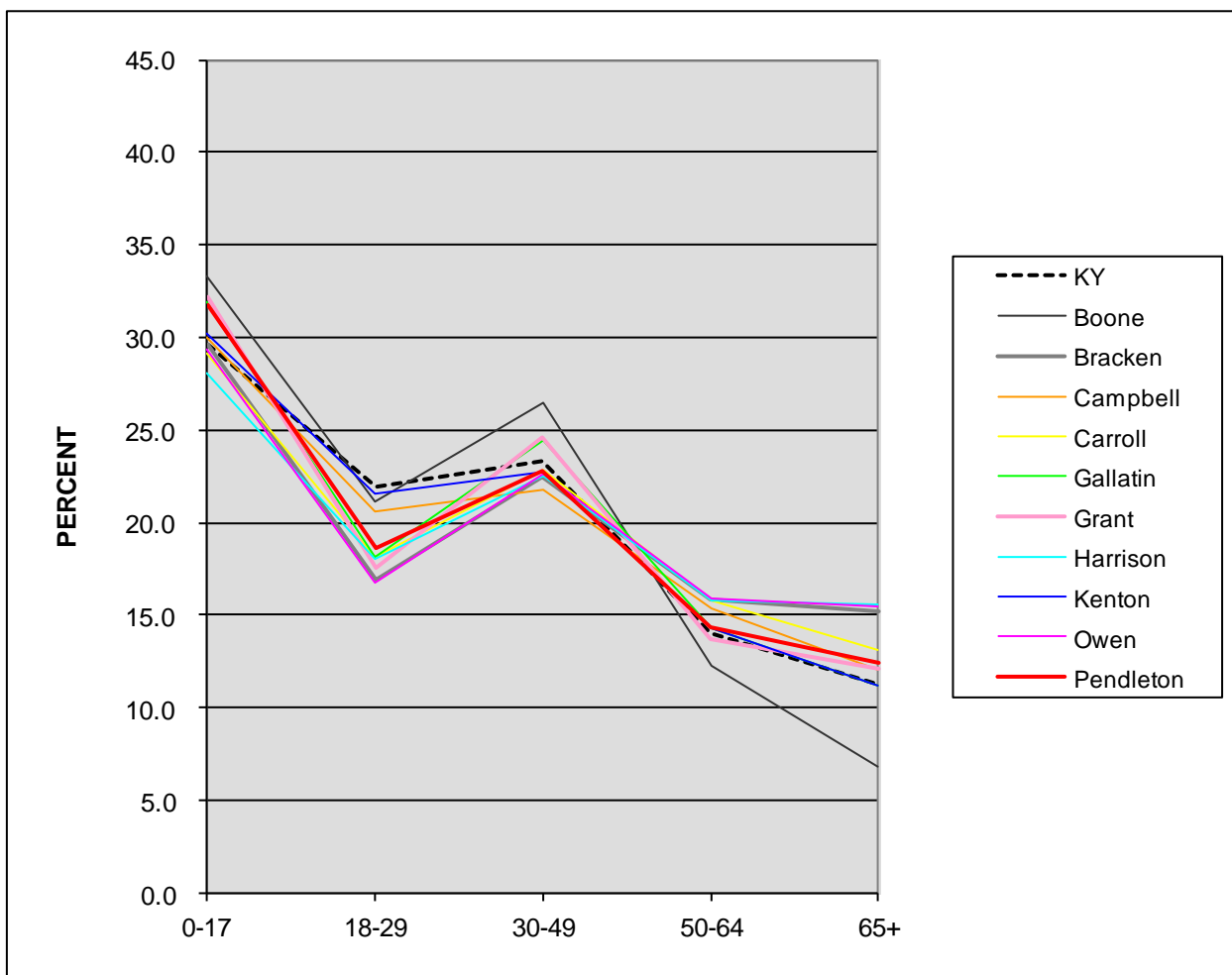

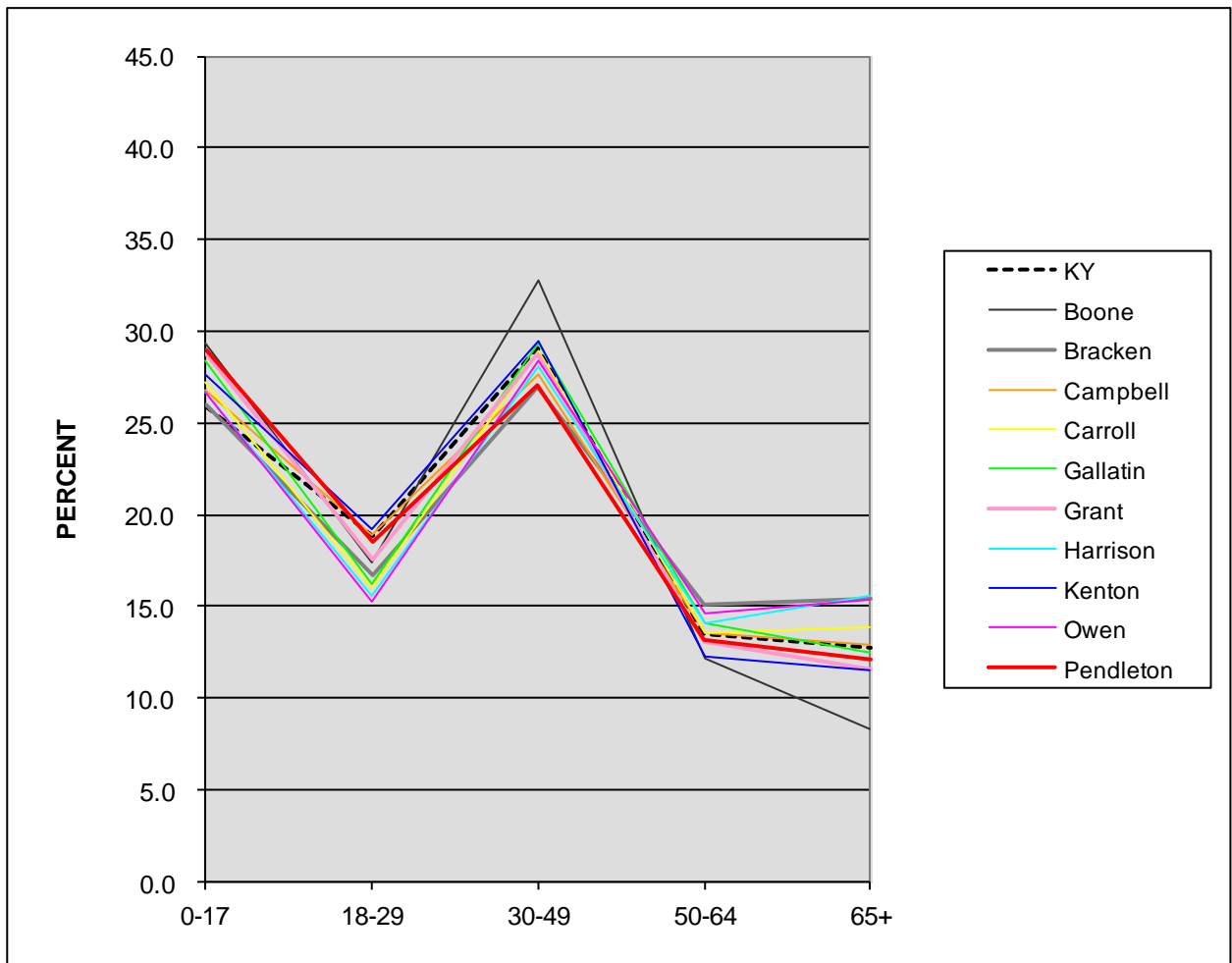

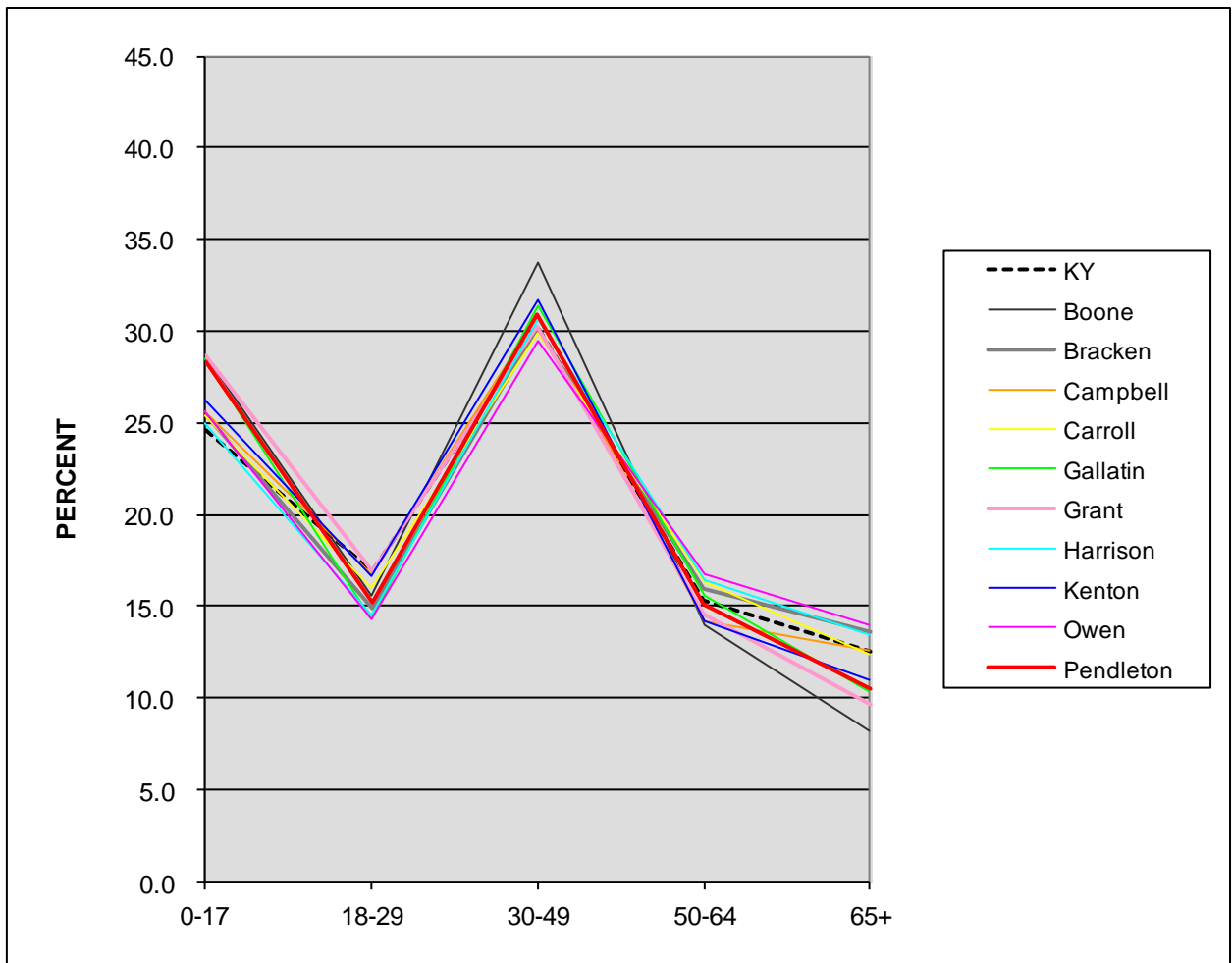

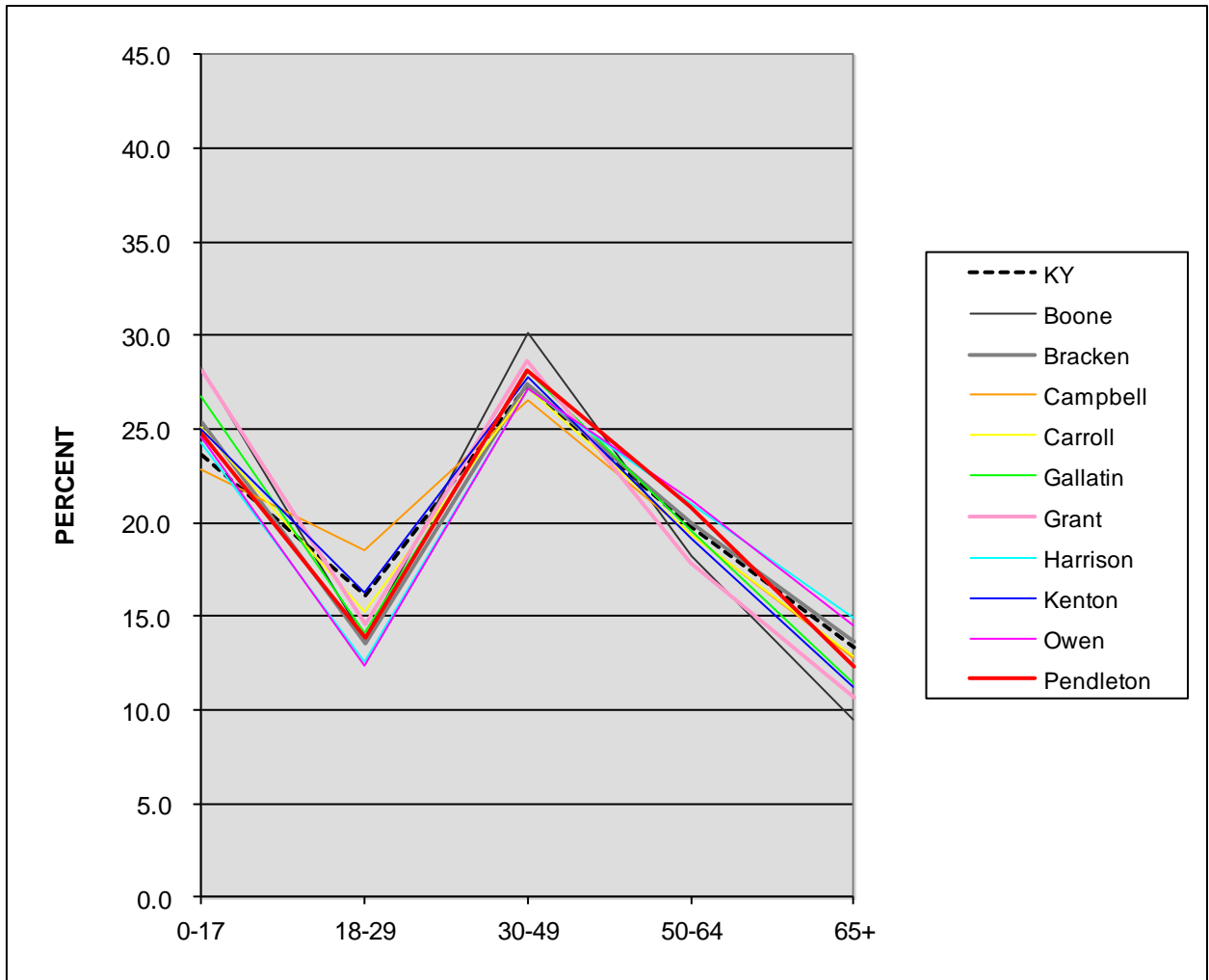

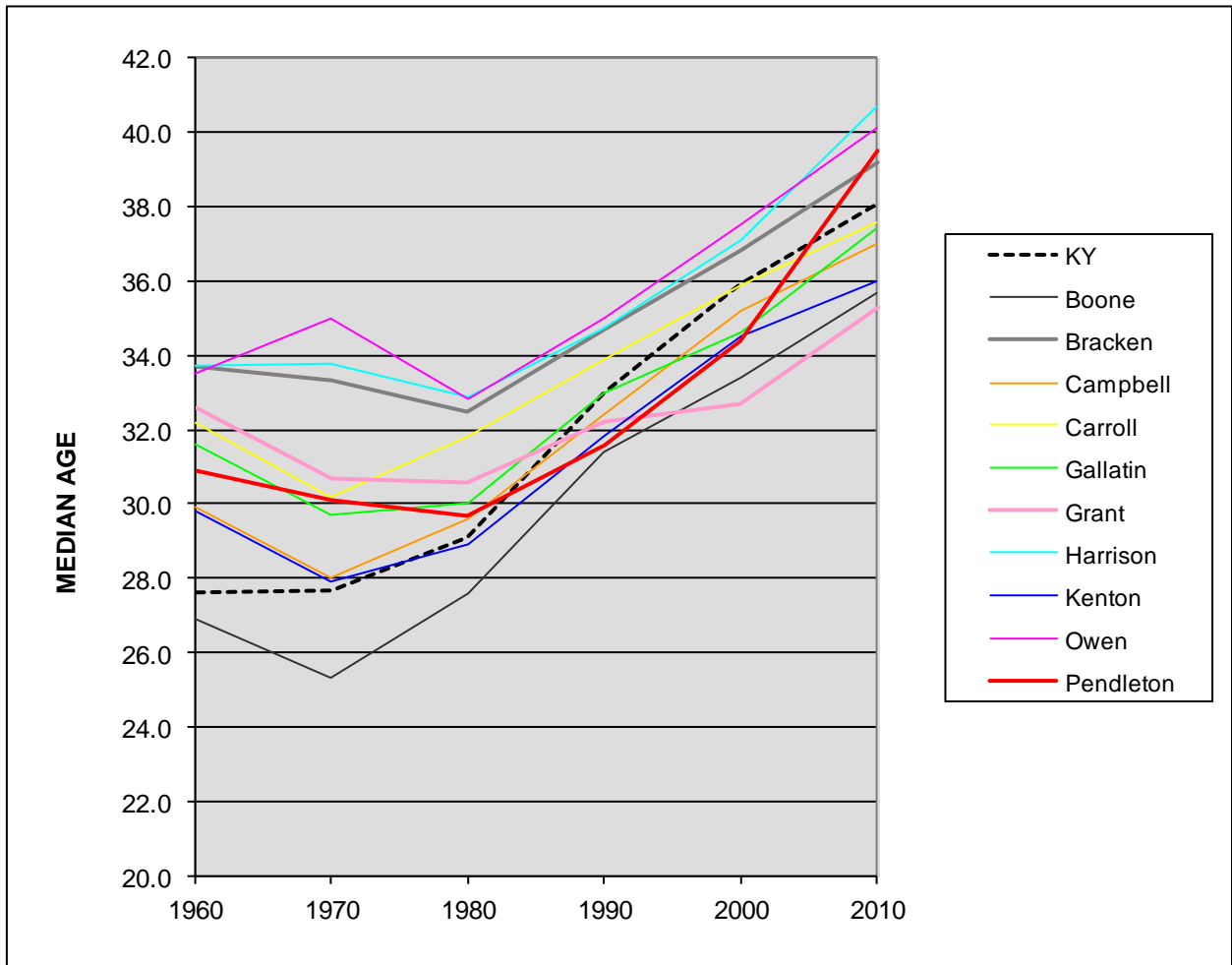

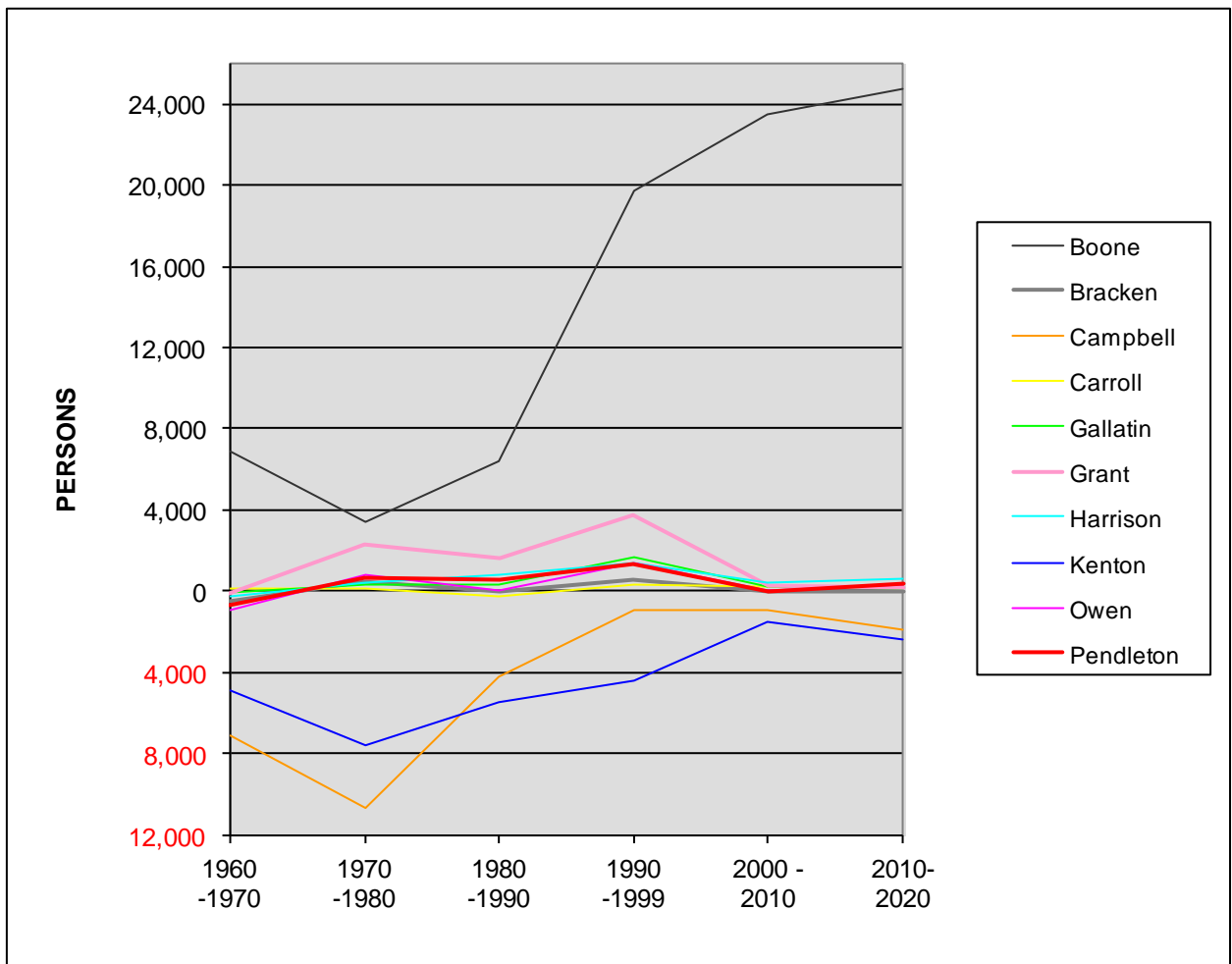

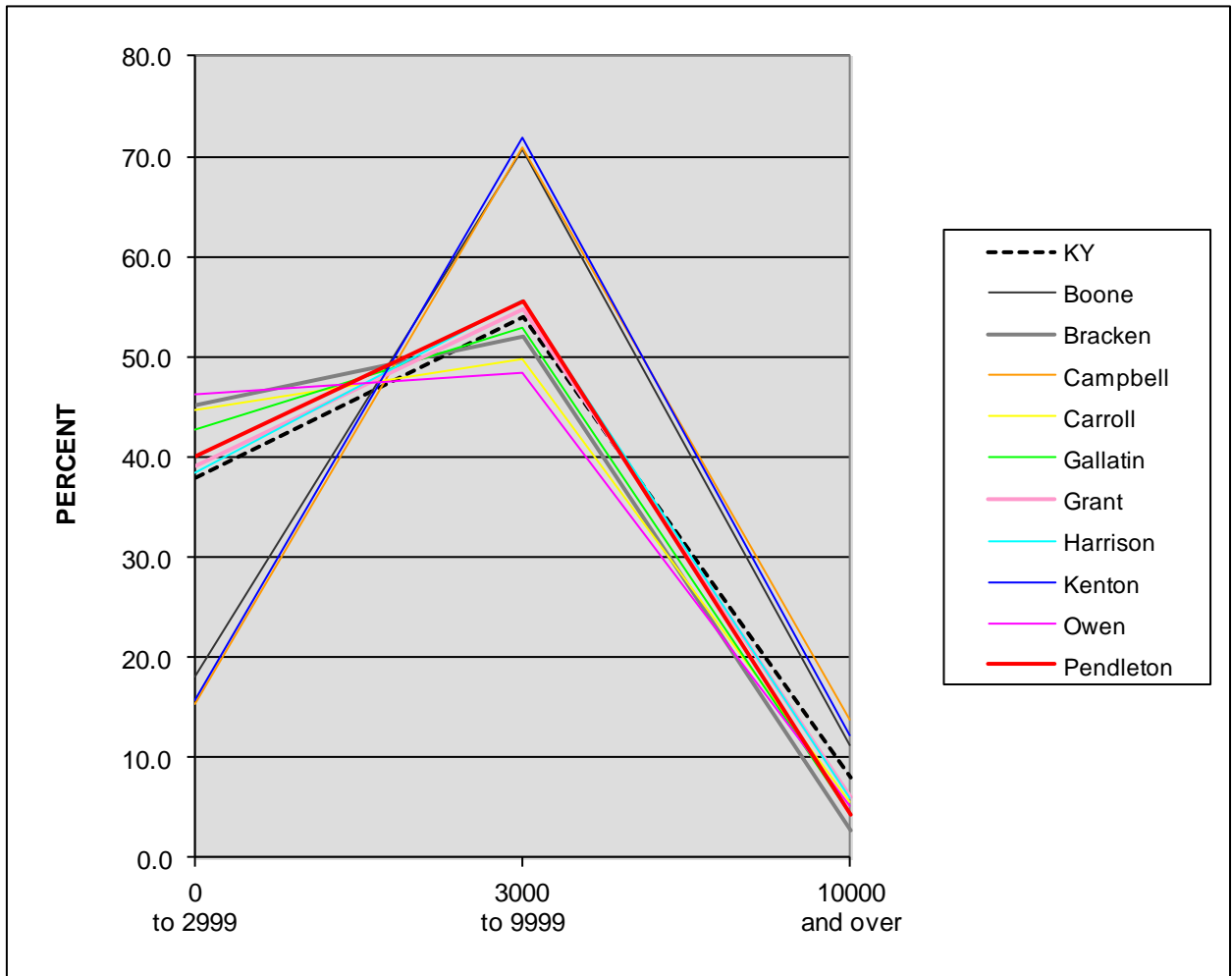

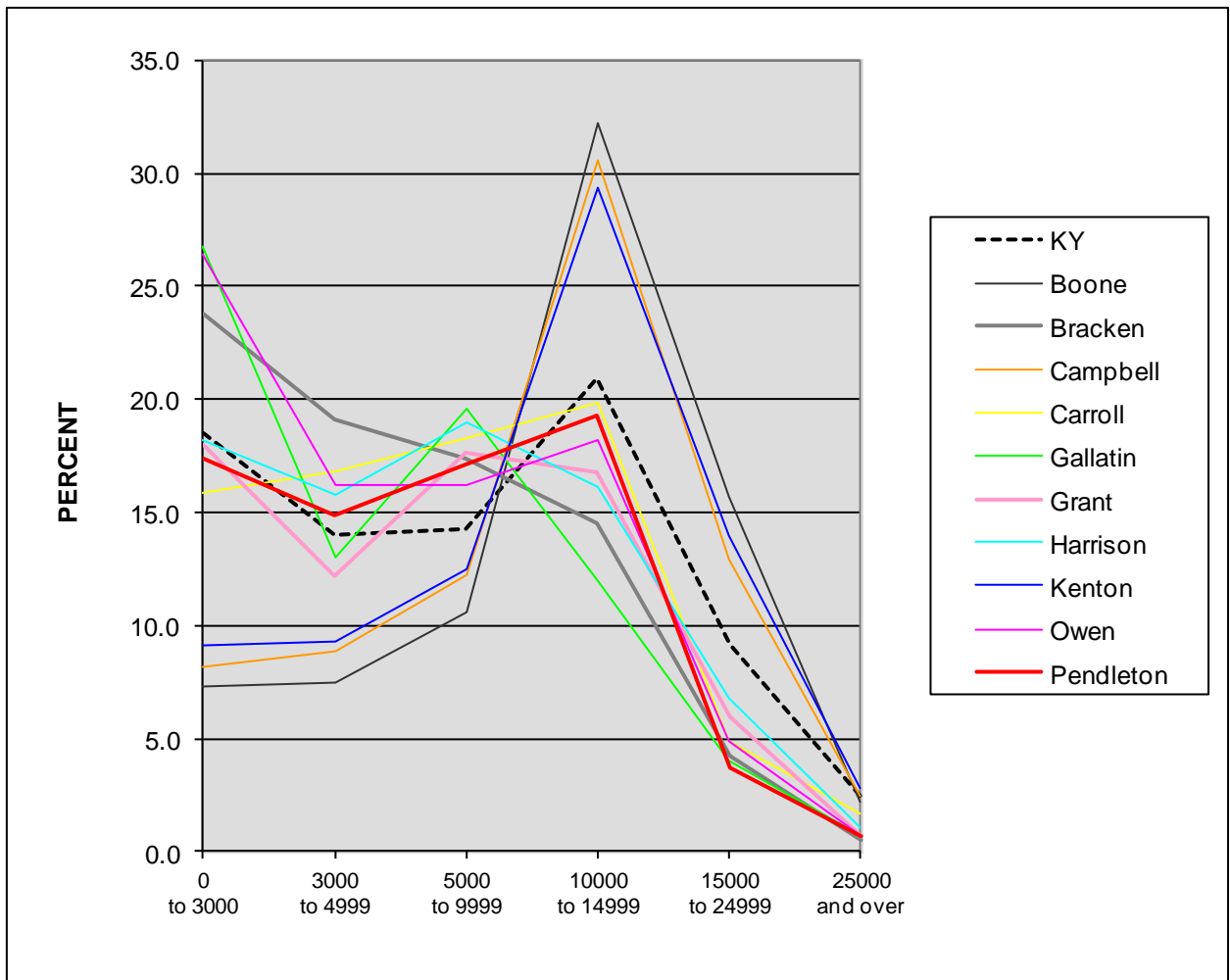

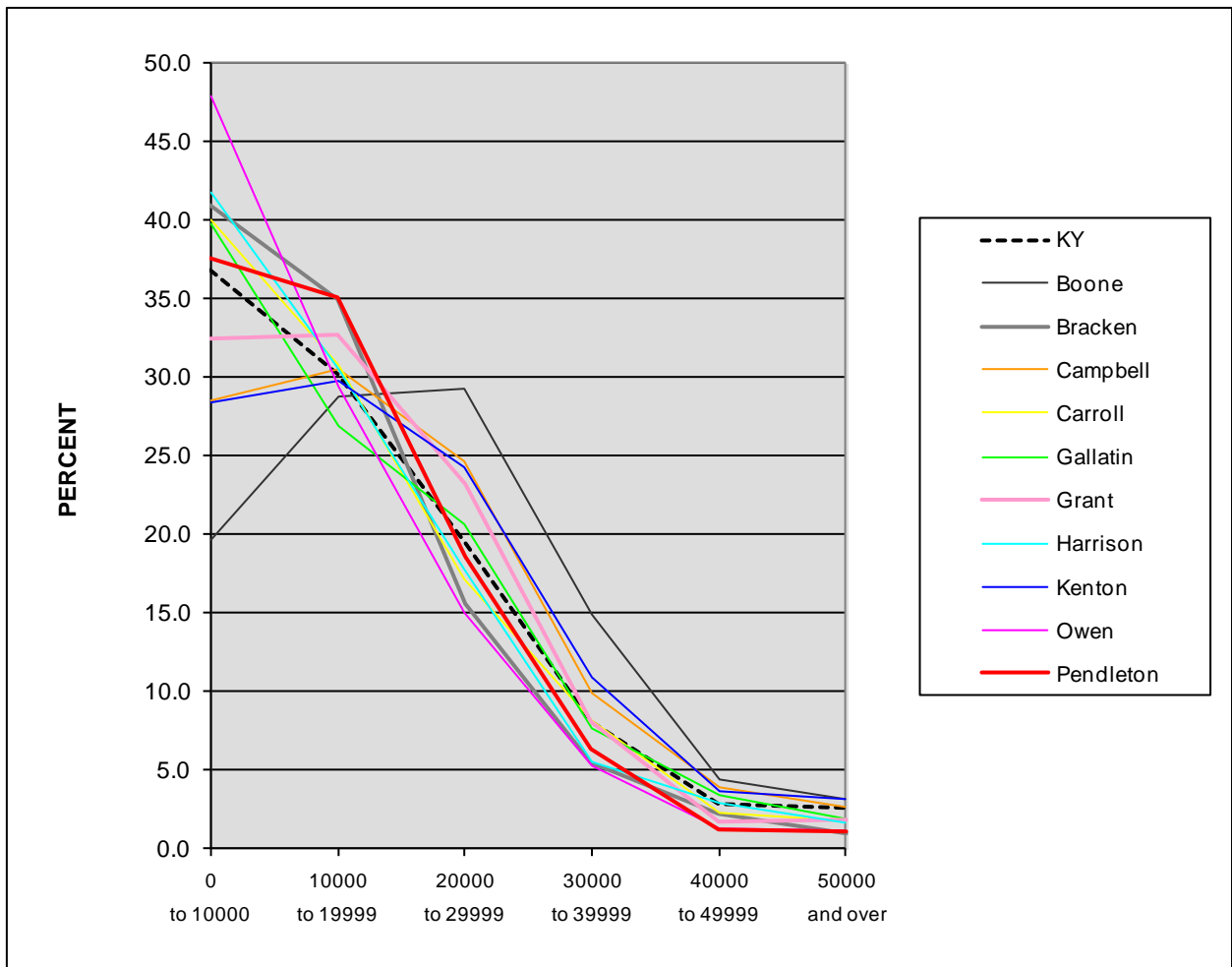

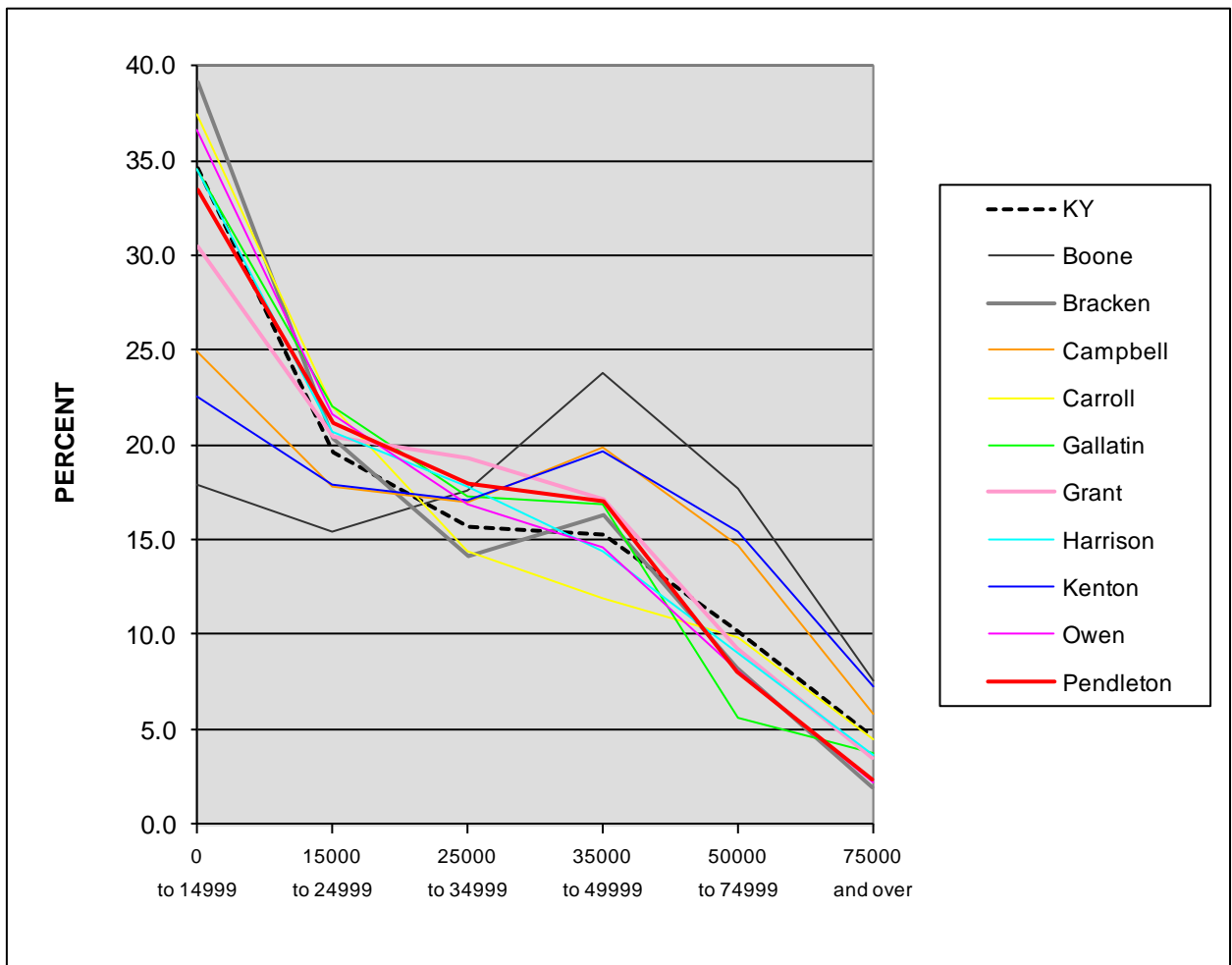

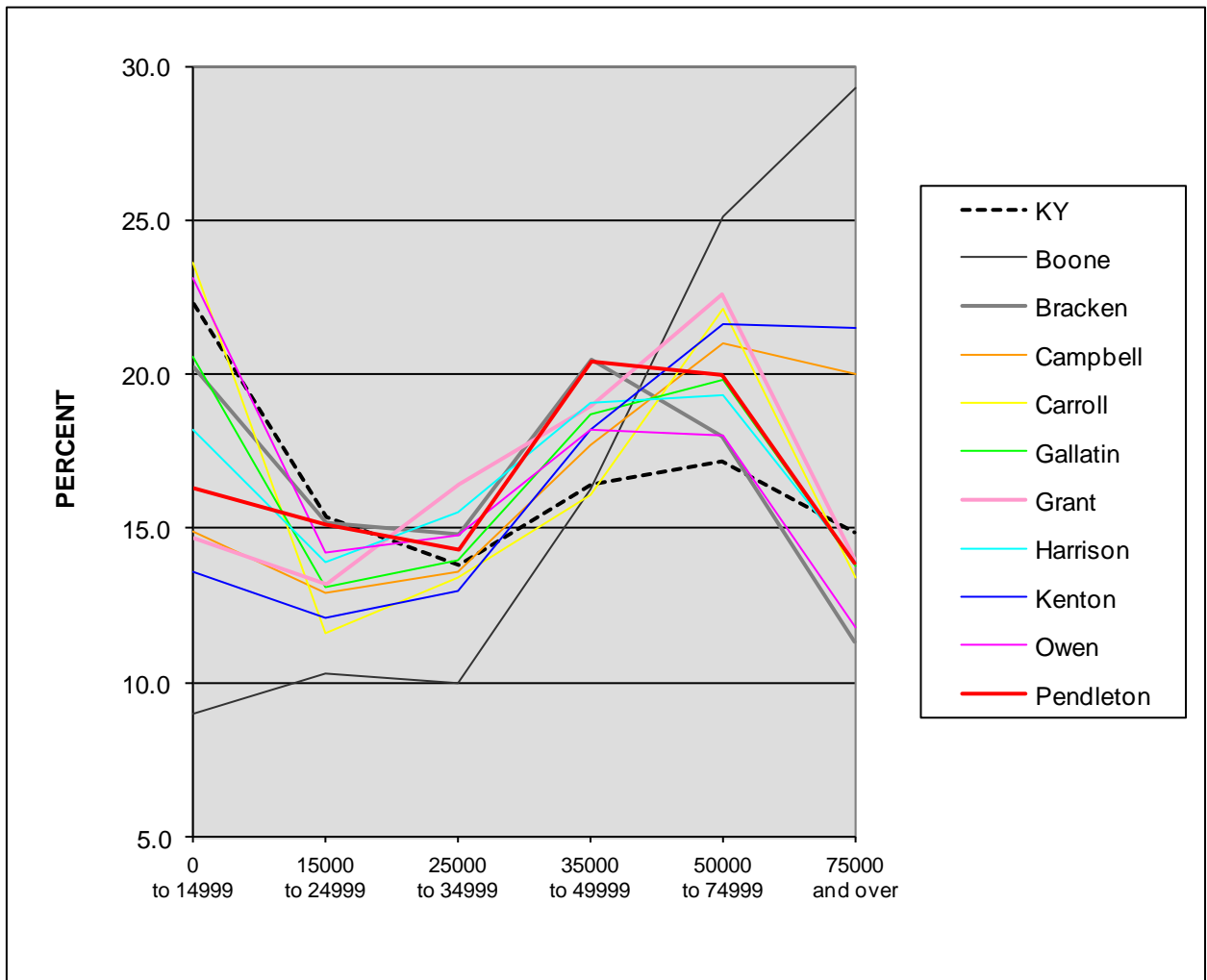

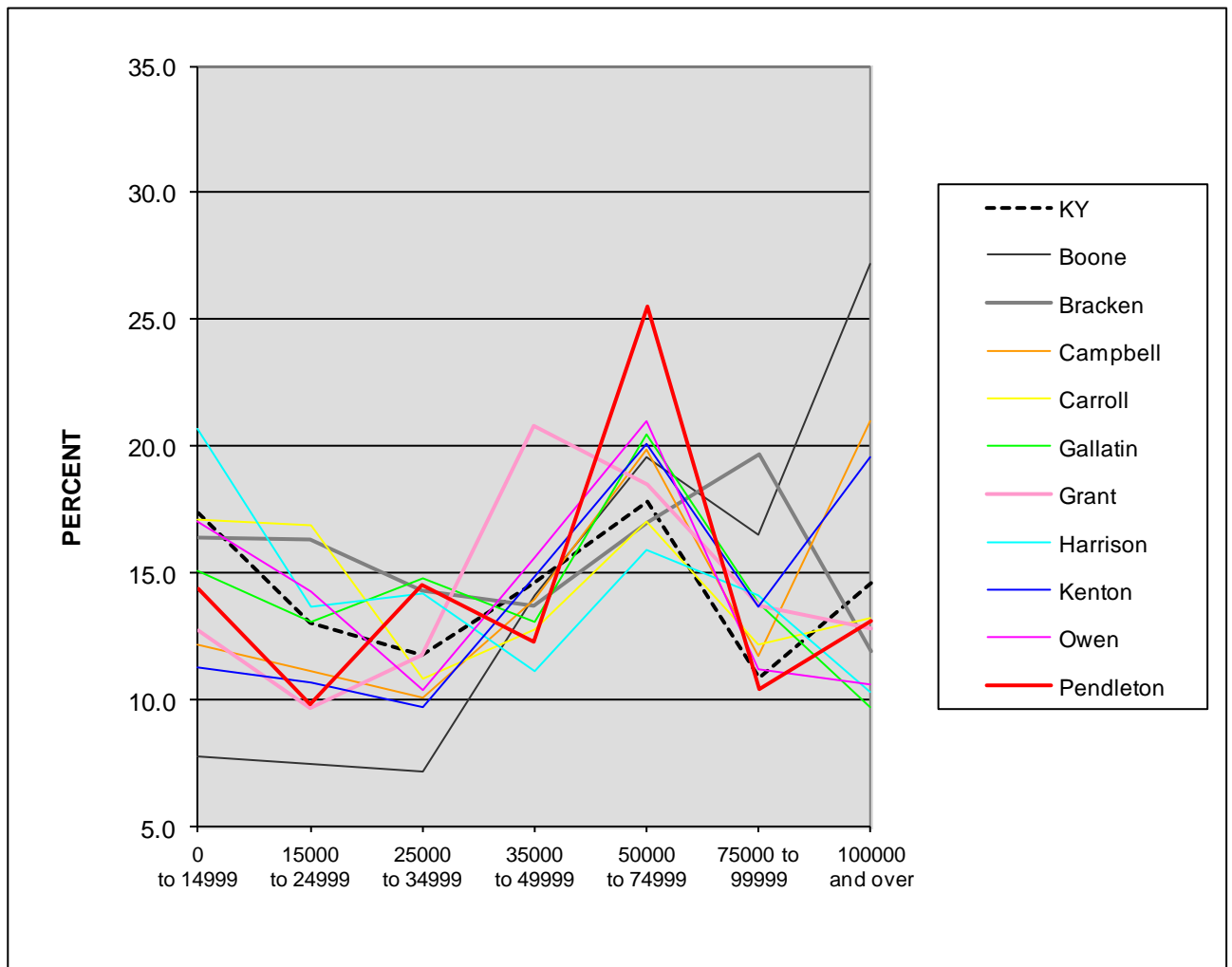

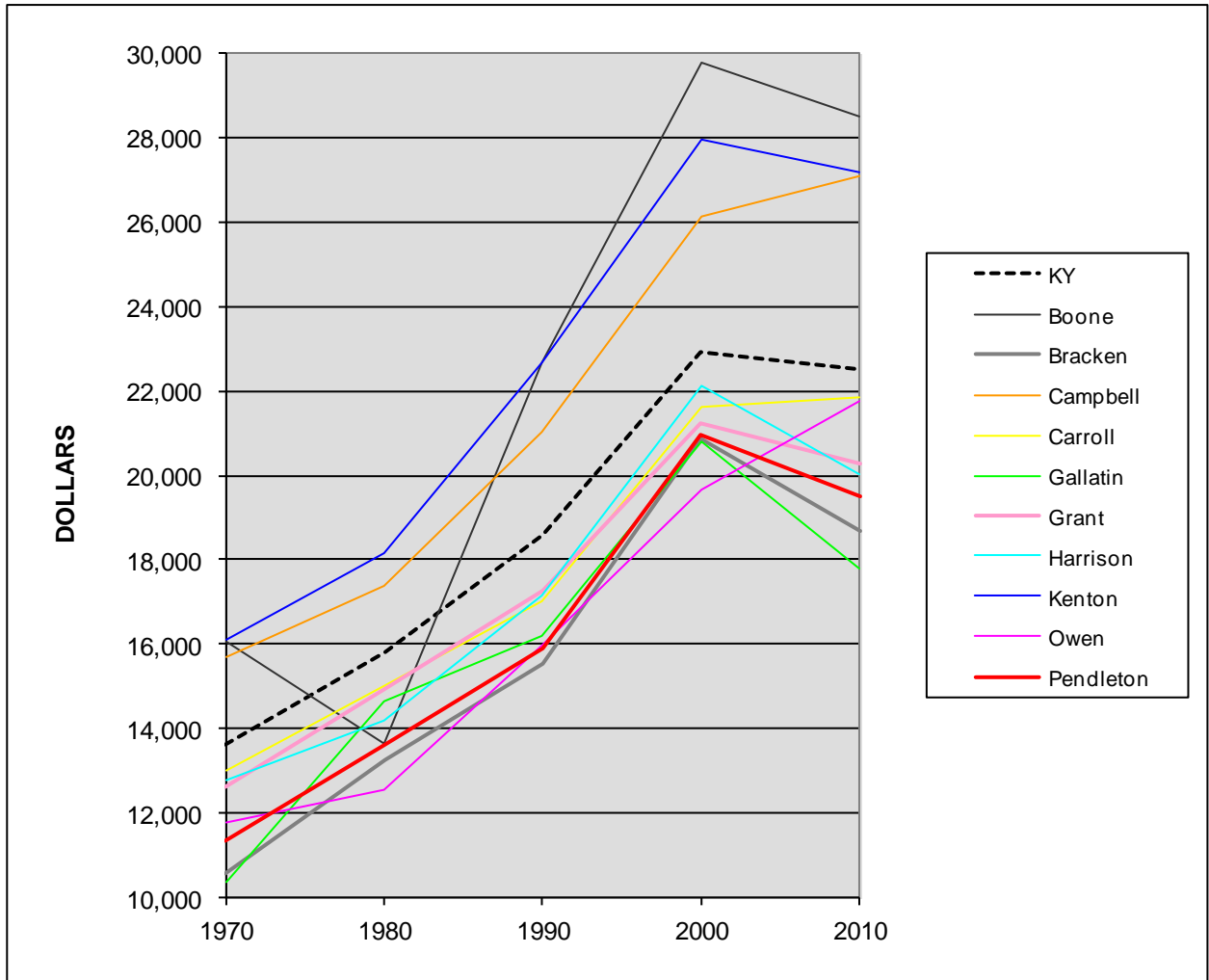

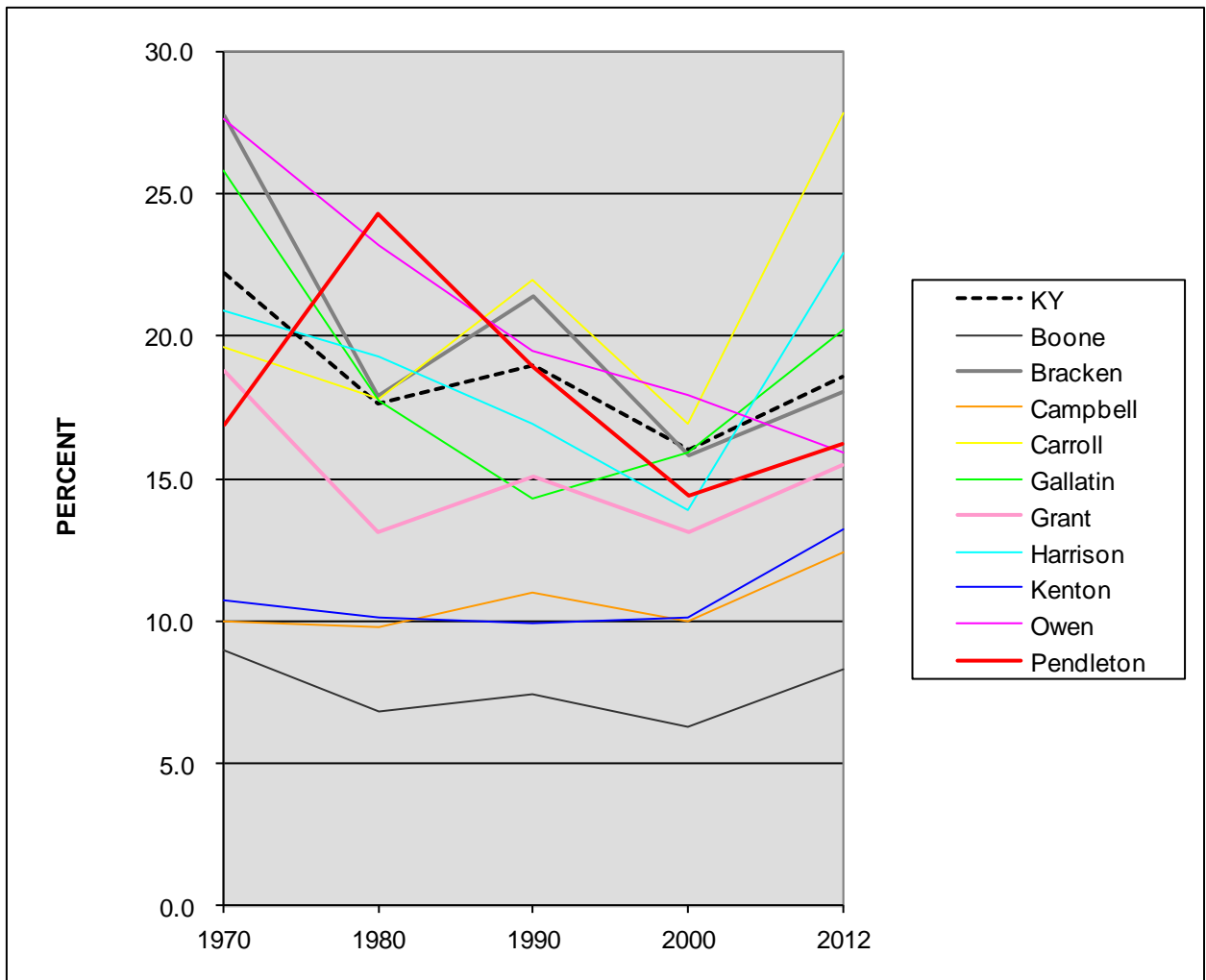

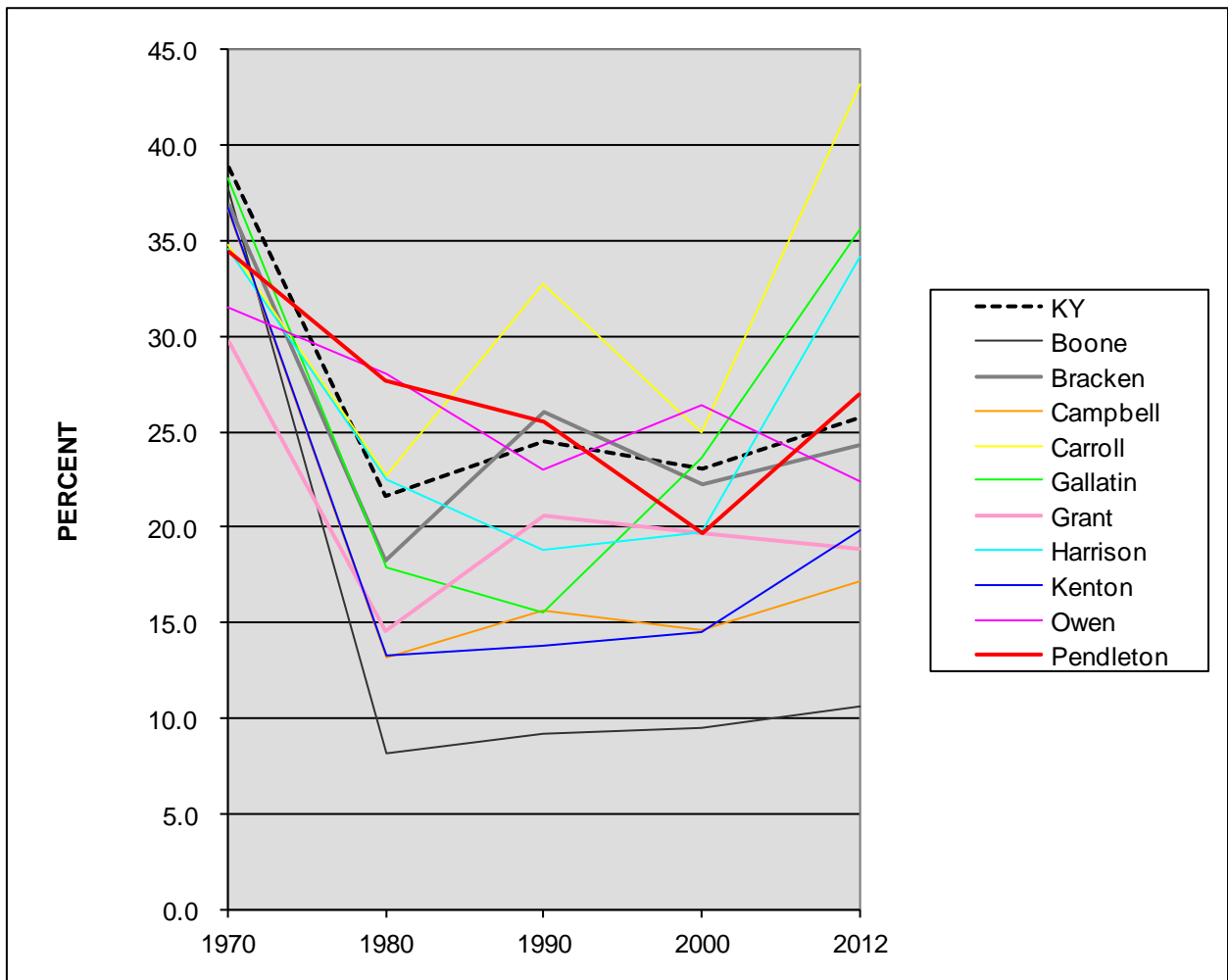

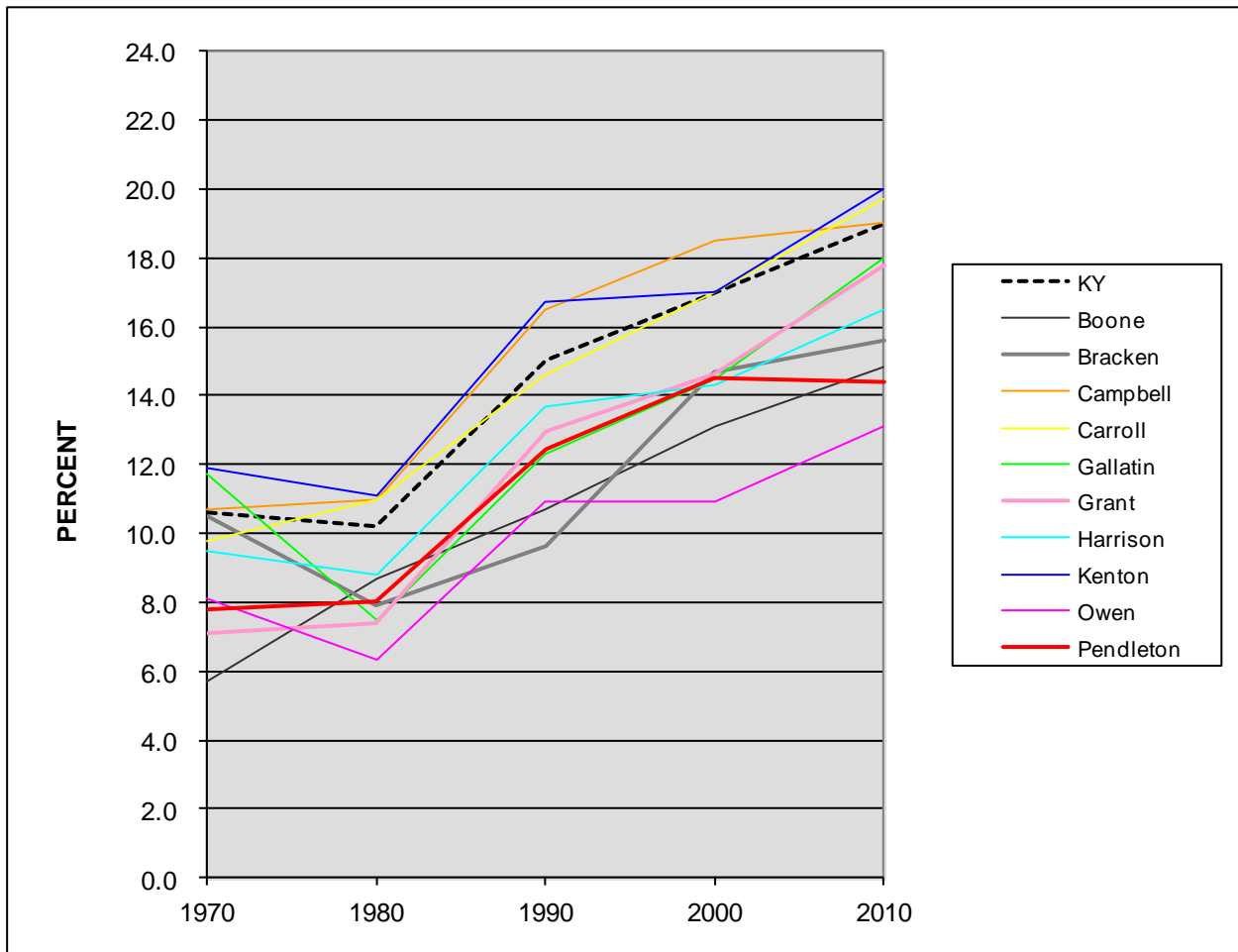

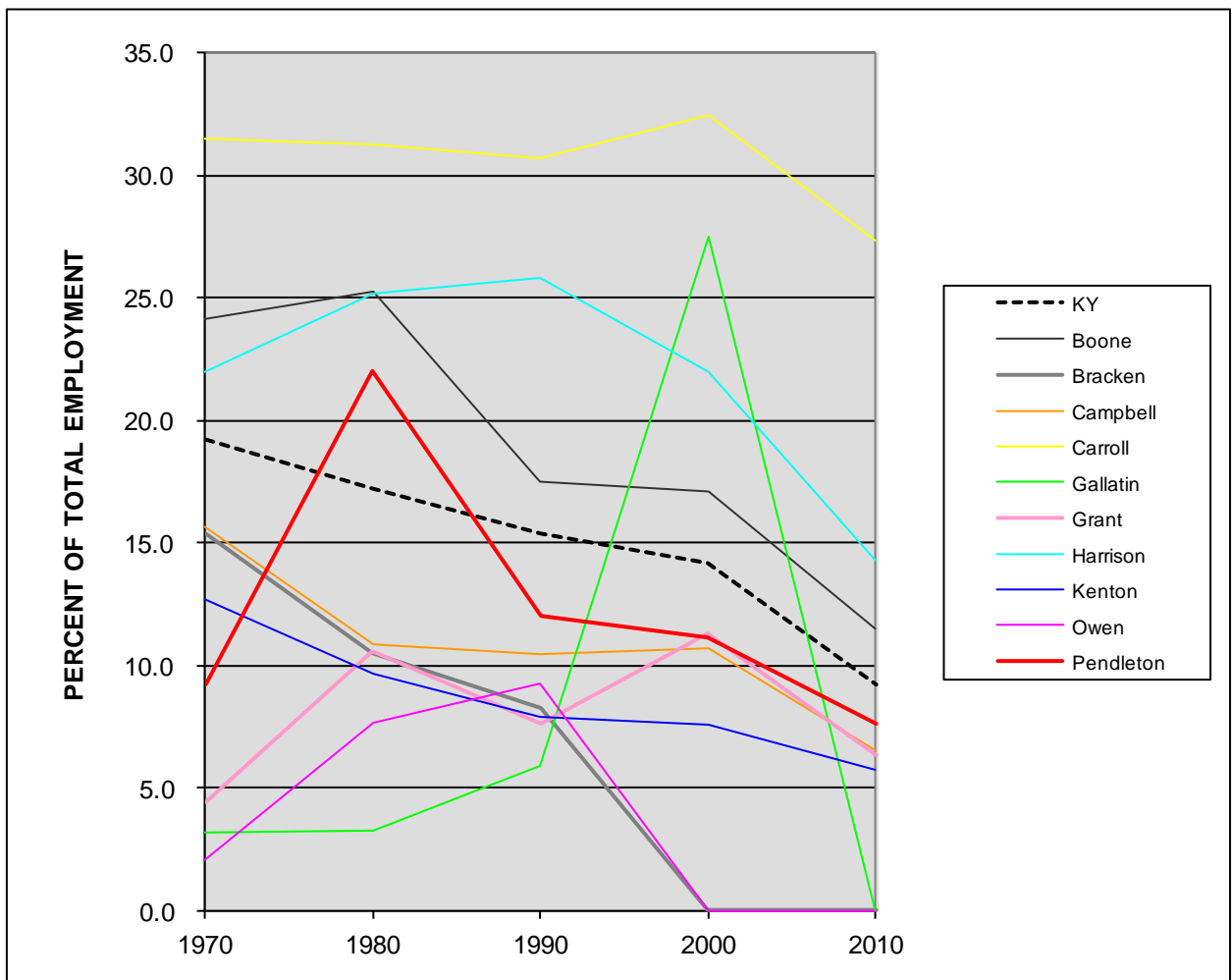

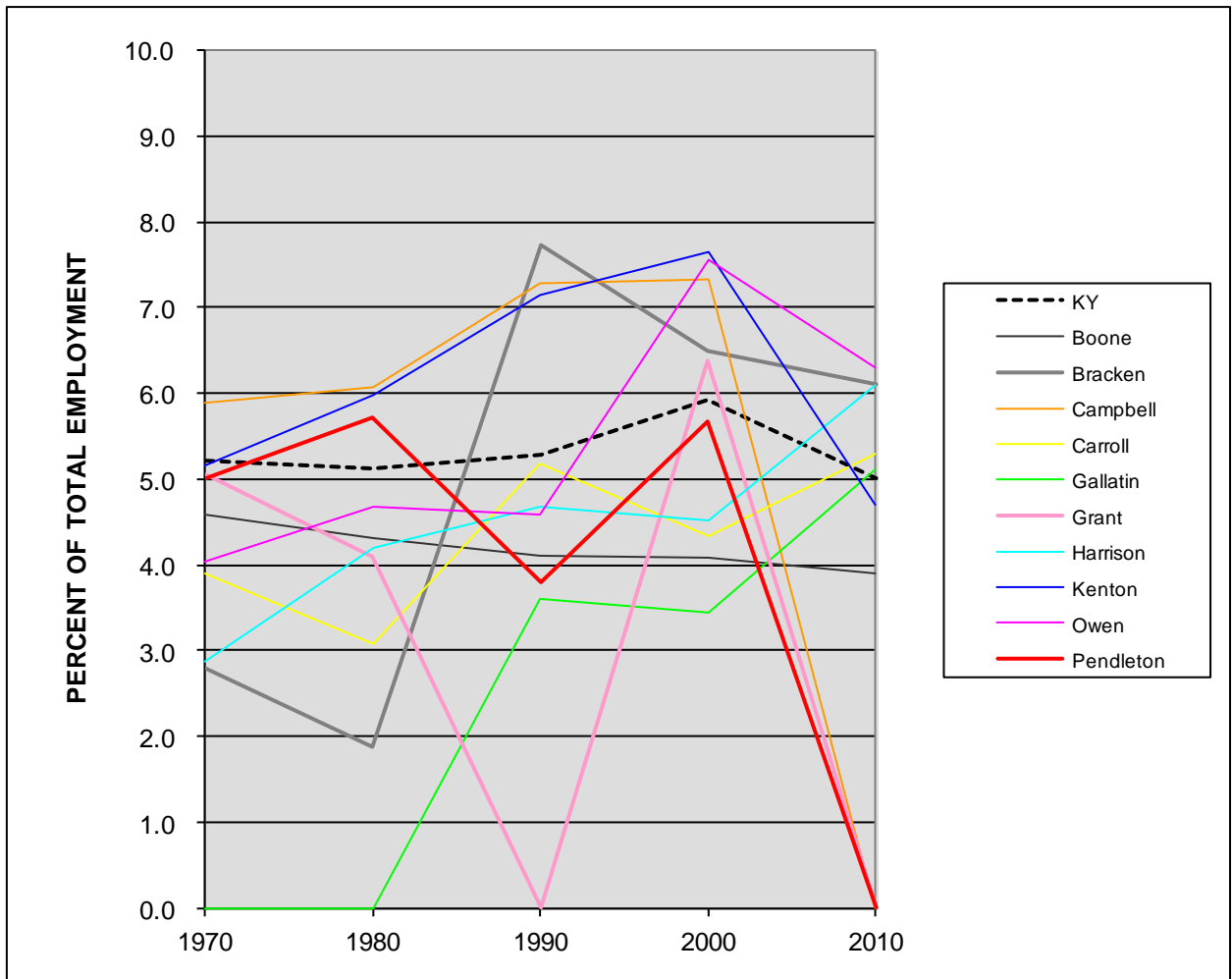

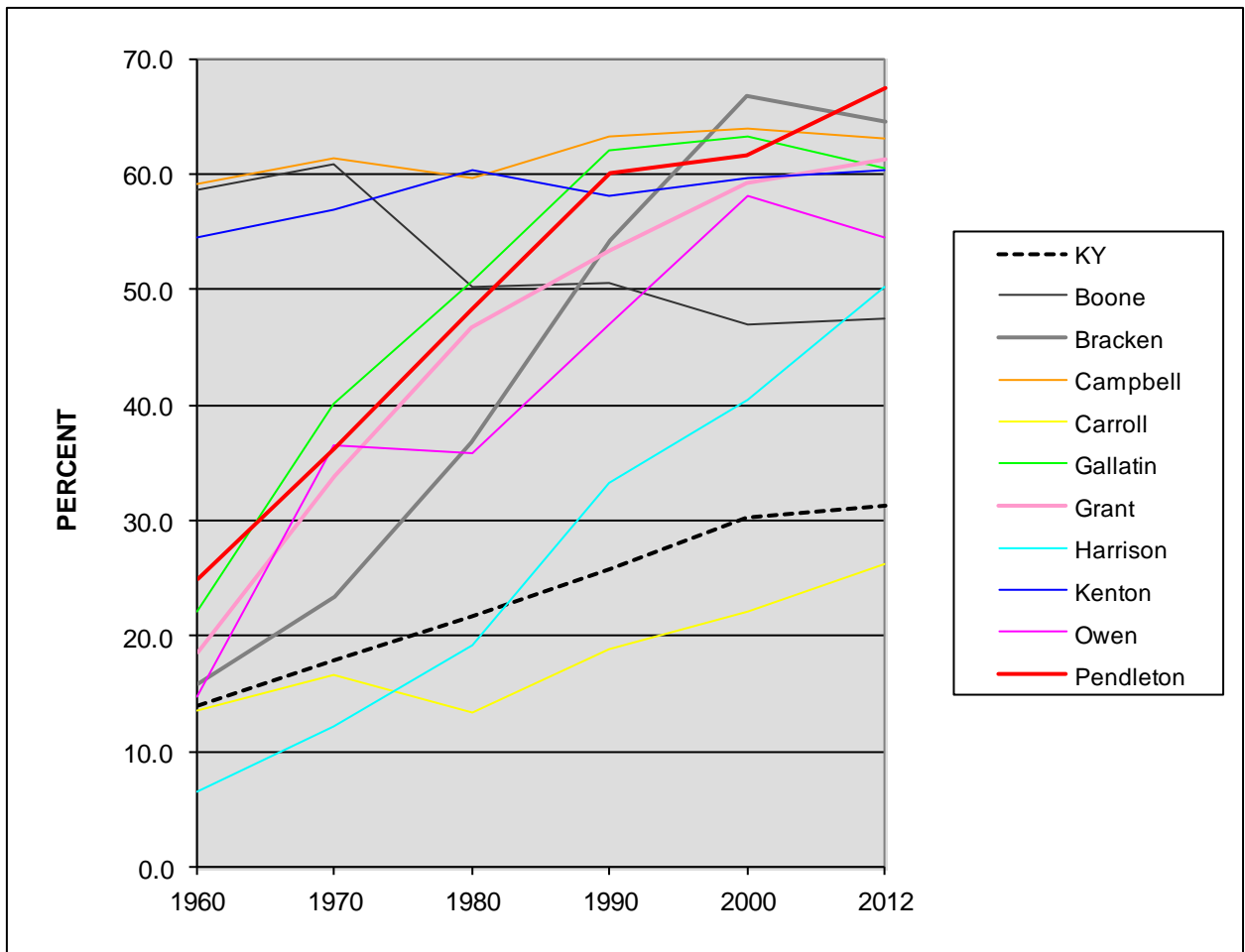

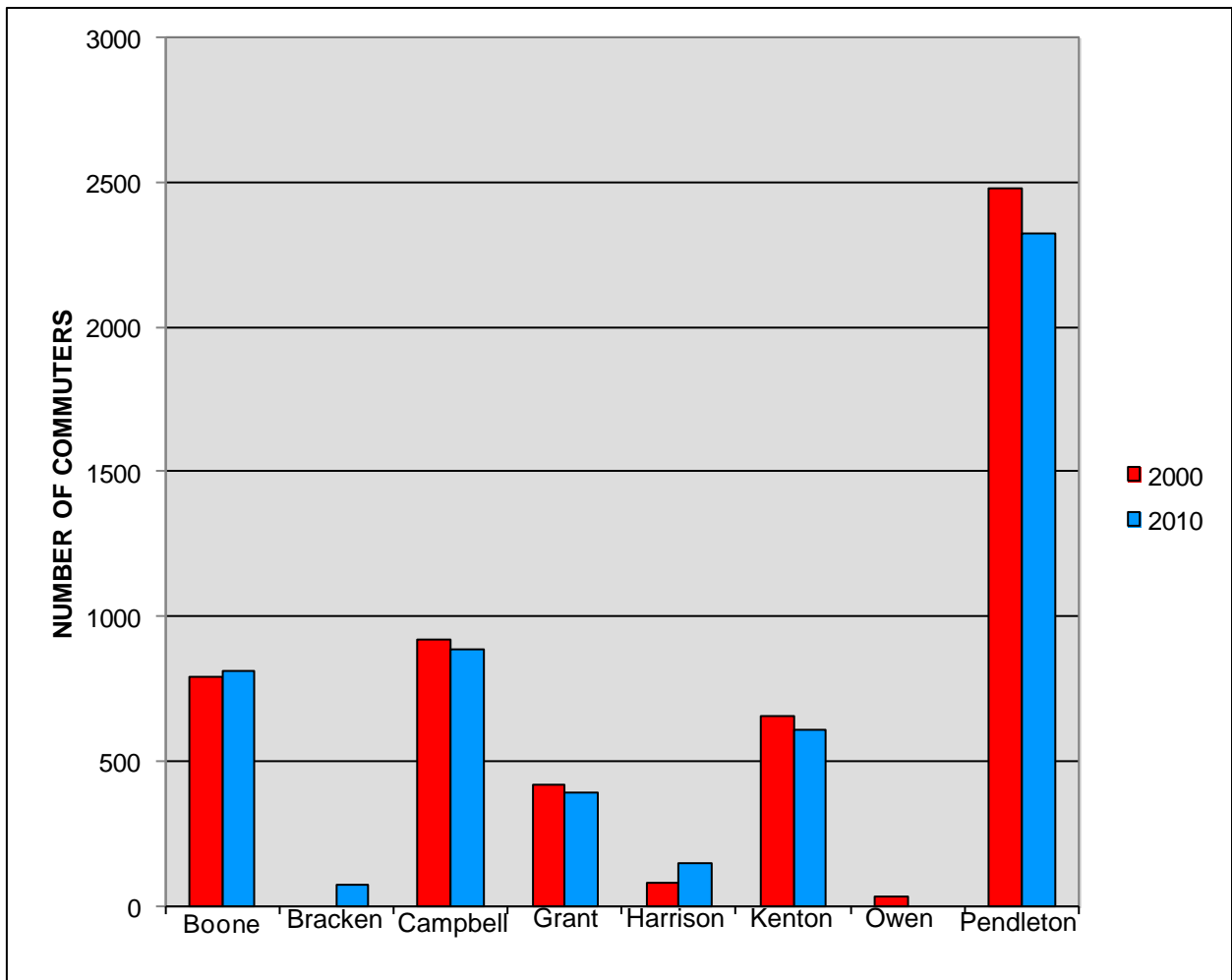

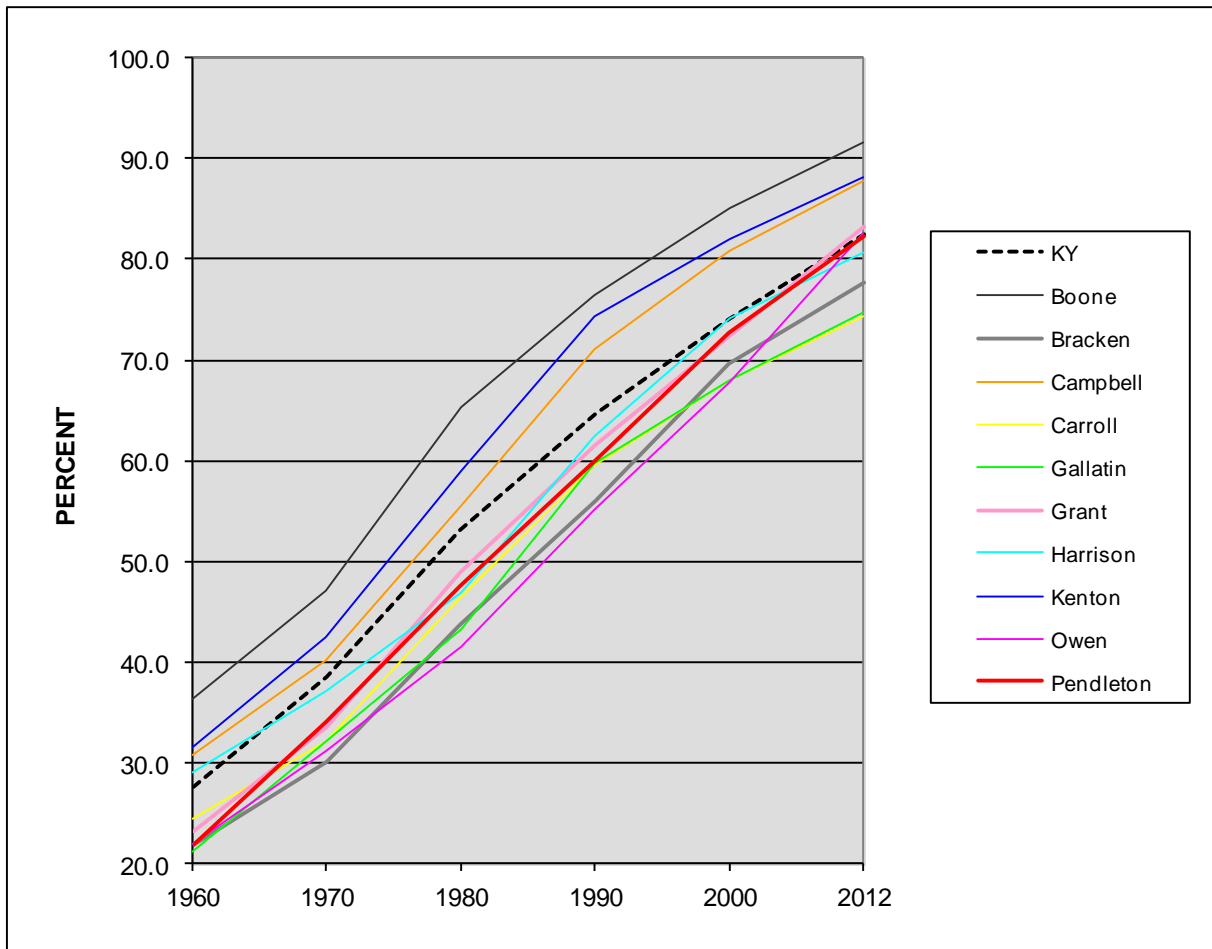

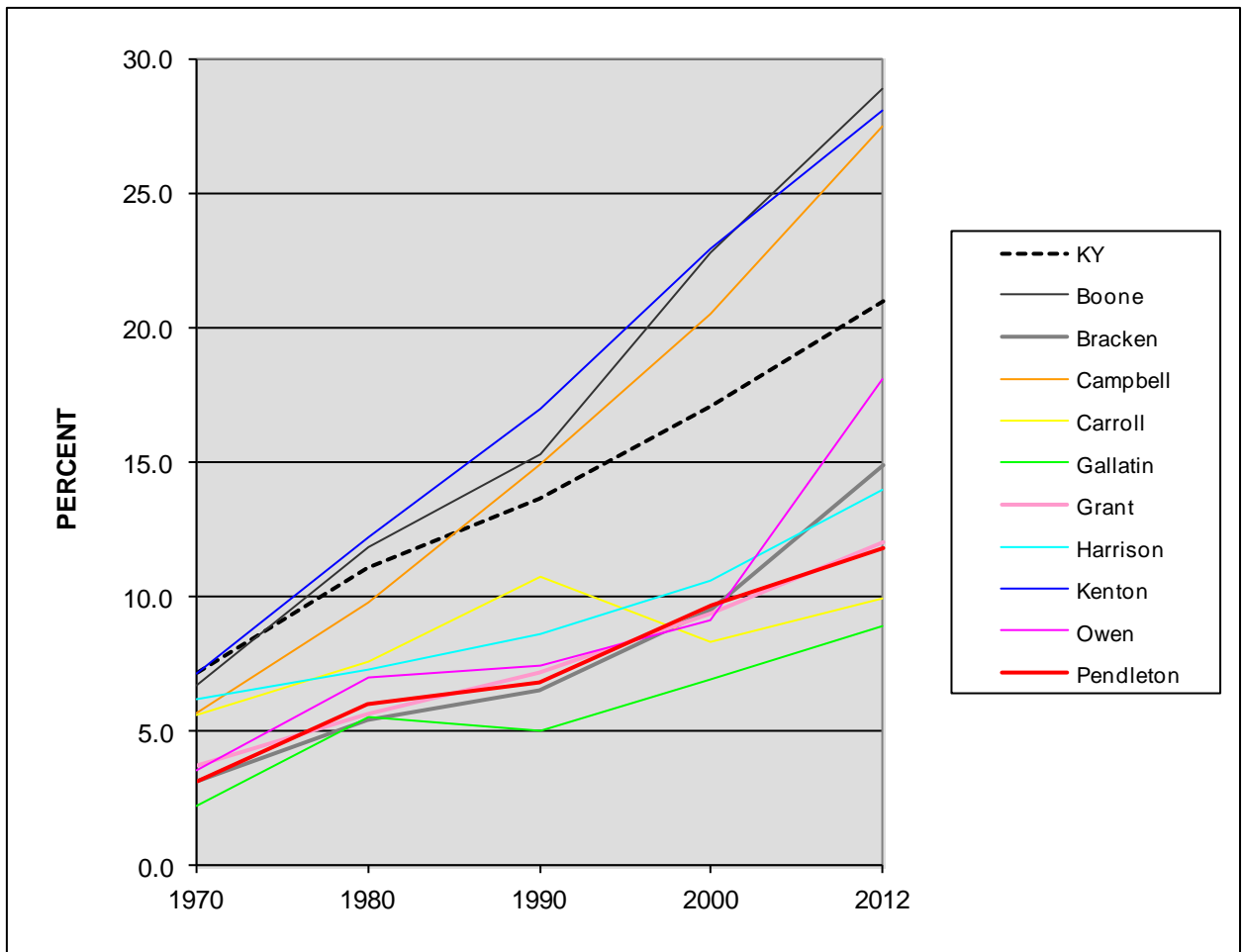

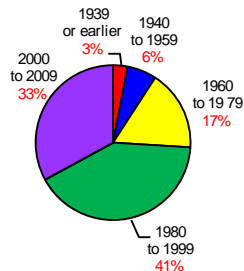

PERCENTAGE OF HOUSING UNITS BUILT BY DECADE¹

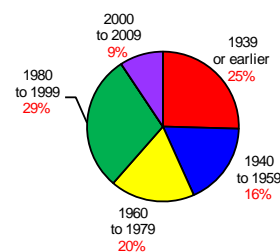

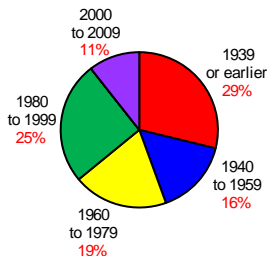

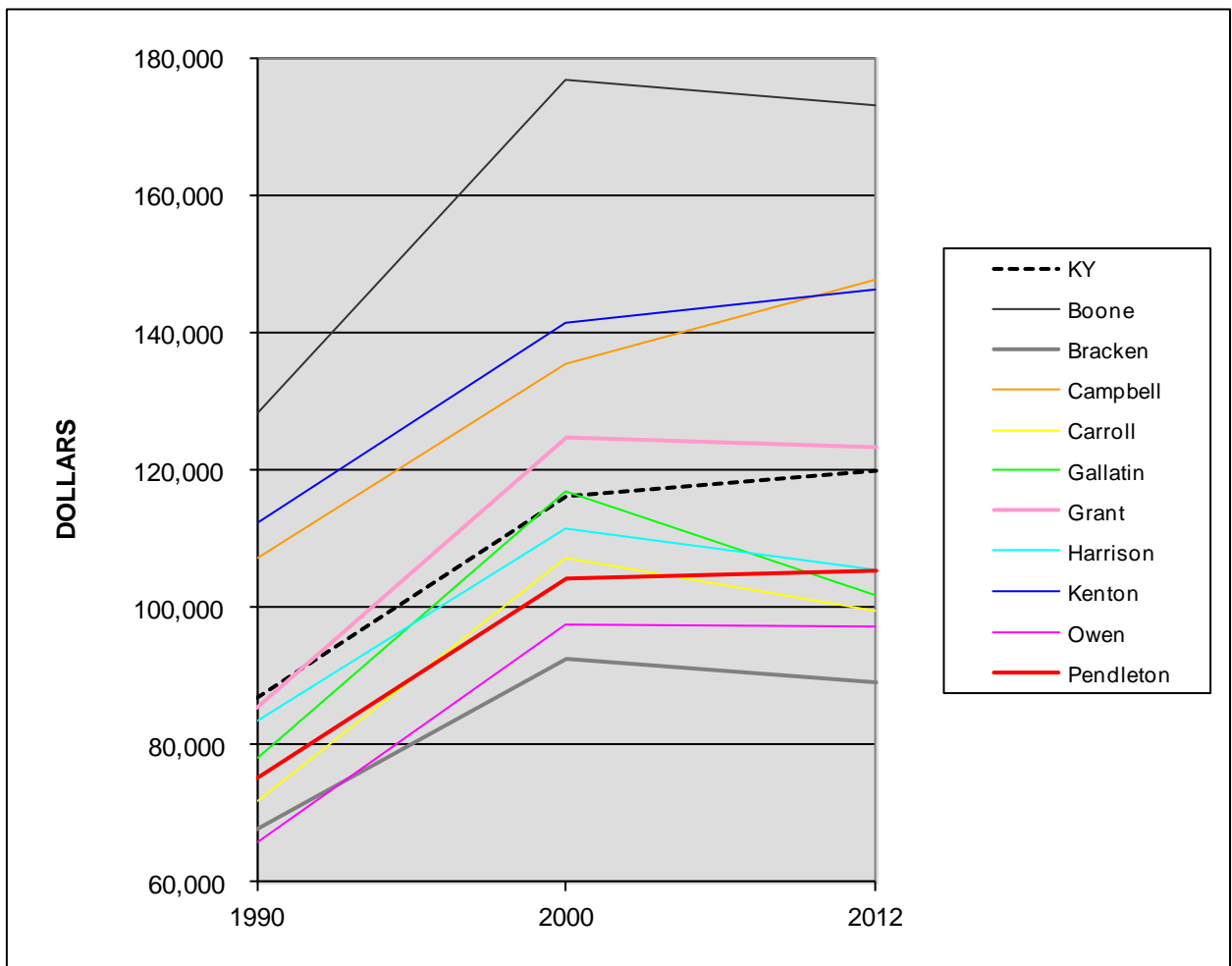

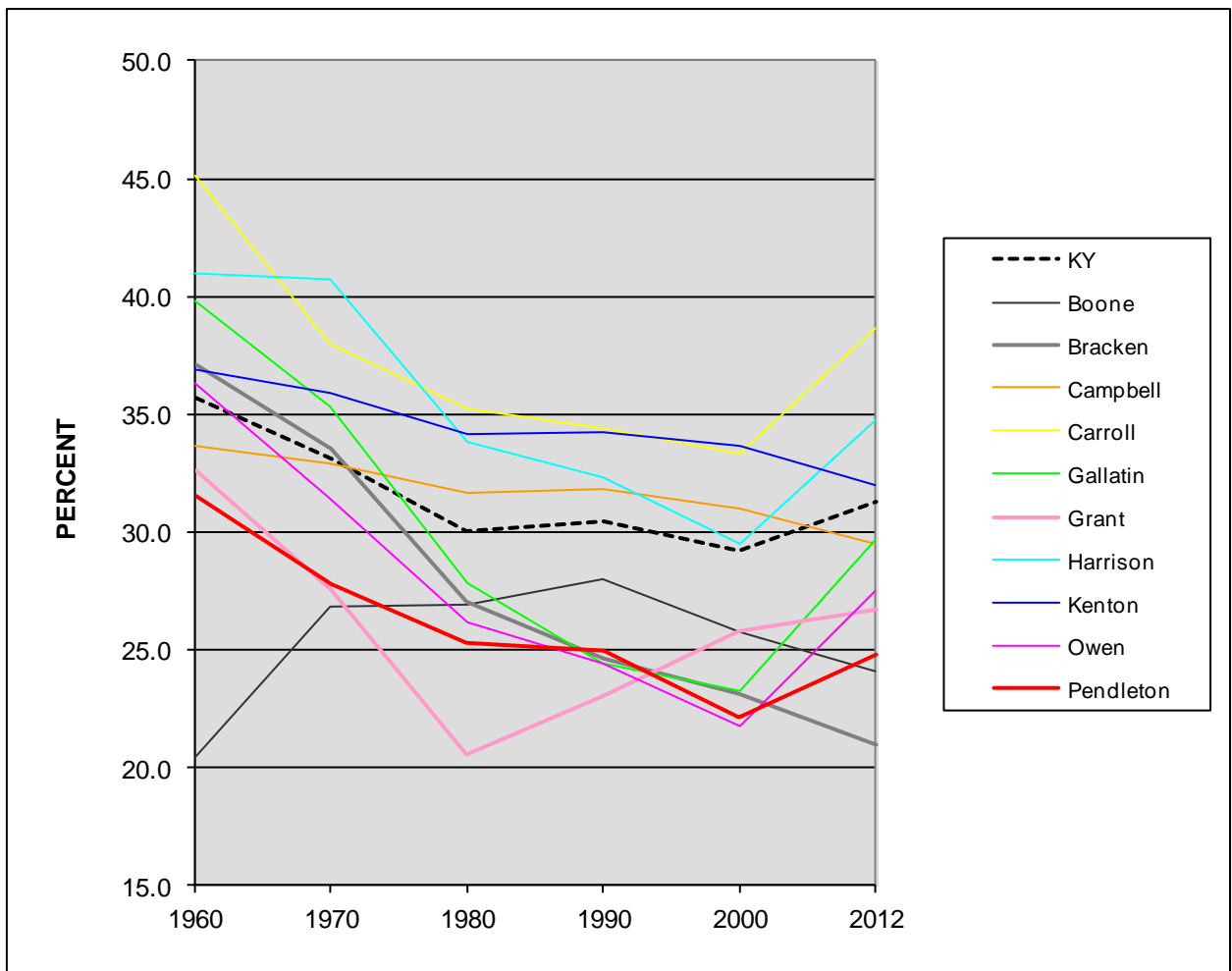

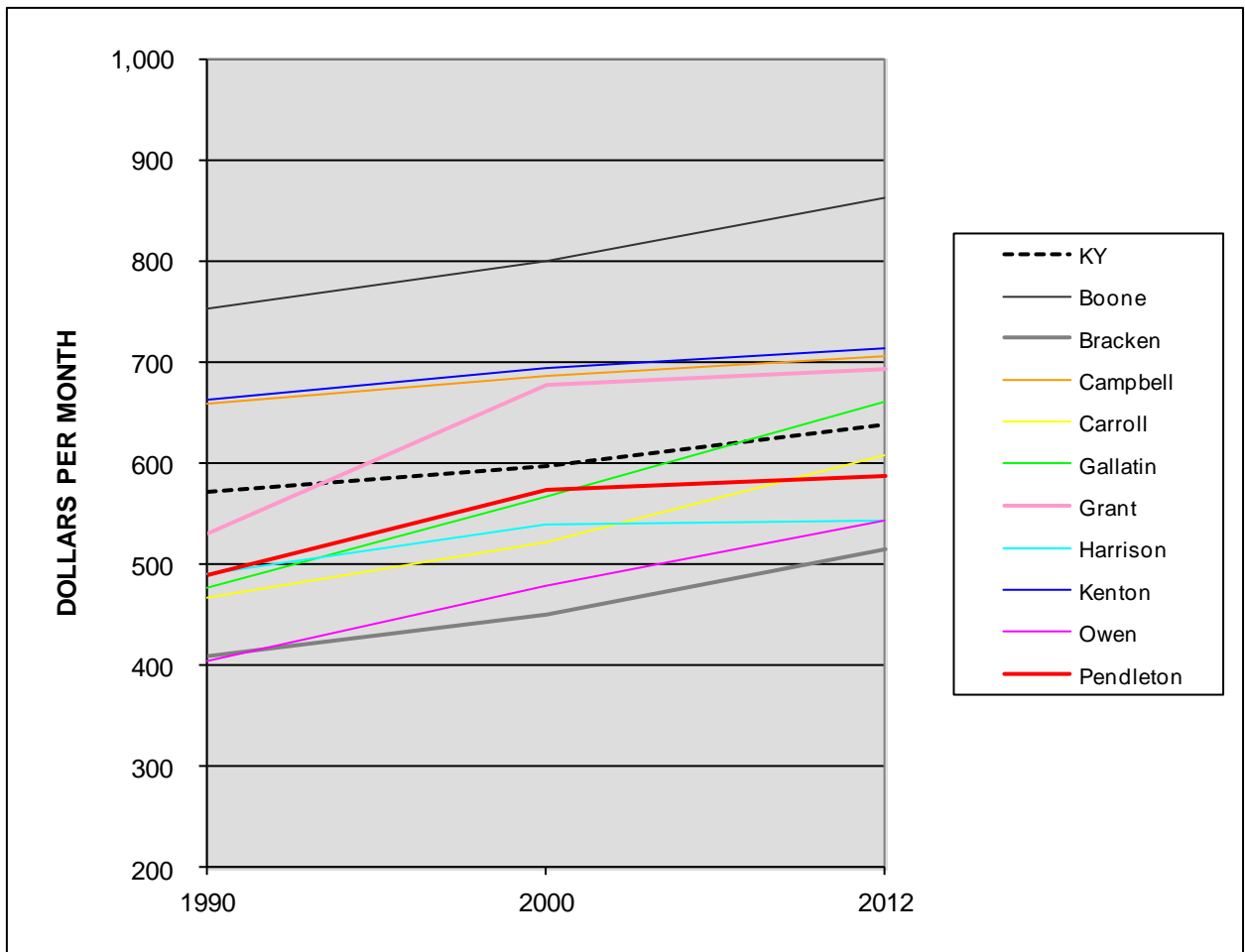

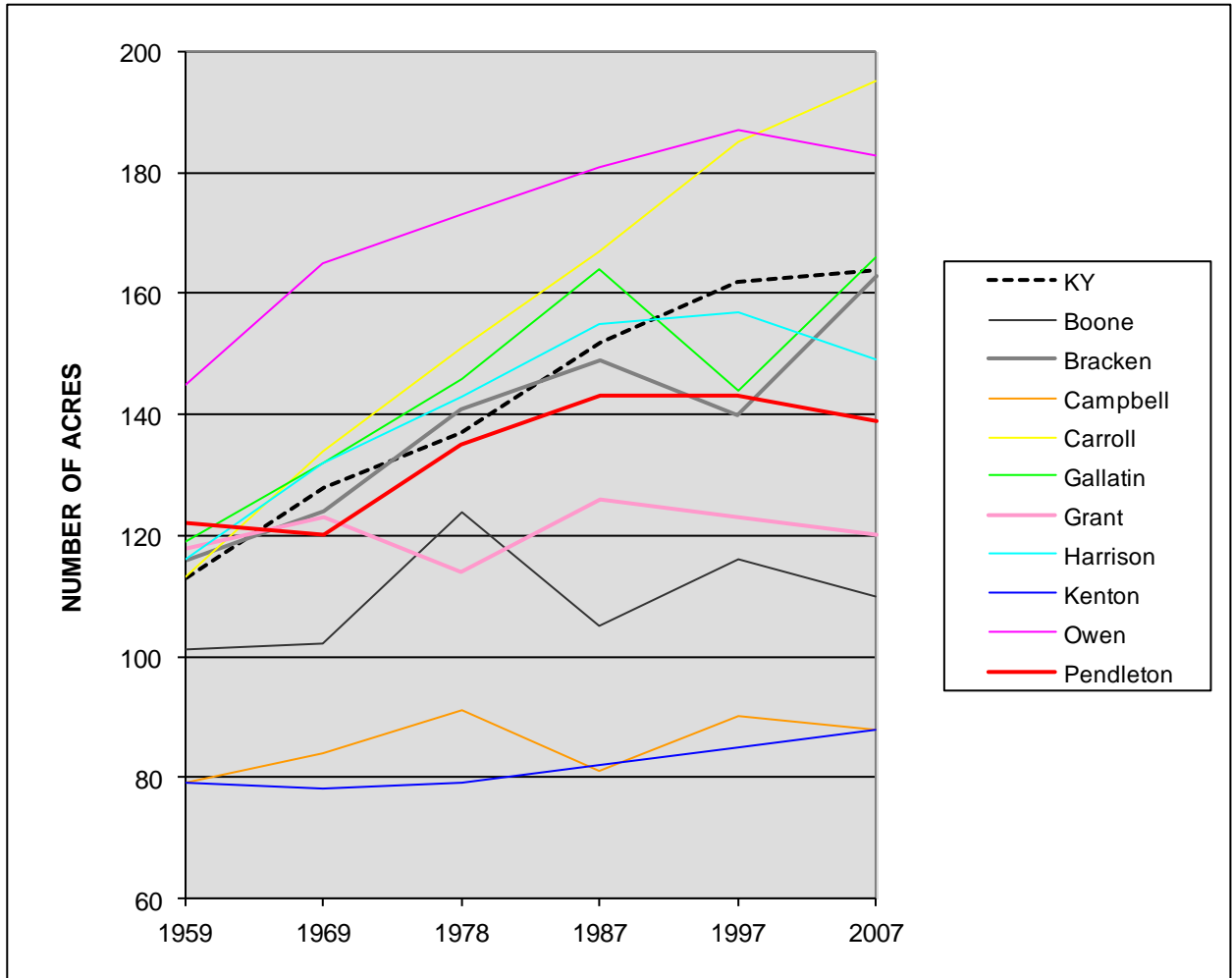
