Training Overview

Gas Metal Arc Course:

This course covers identification, inspection, and maintenance of GMAW machines; identification, selection and storage of GMAW electrodes; principles and the effects of variables on the GMAW process. Learn the practical application and manipulative skills of Gas Metal Arc Welding and the proper safety measures. Ferrous metals will be covered, as well as various joint designs on plate in all positions.

Shielded Metal Arc Course:

Learn the identification, inspection, principles and maintenance of SMAW electrodes; the effects of variables on the SMAW process to weld plate.

This program encompasses 40 hours of both Stick / Mig welding. This is an introductory course only. Successful students will receive a certificate stating they have completed the necessary hours & course work, but this is not a certification program whereby students receive a certification from the American Welding Society.
