A RESOLUTION OF AND BY THE PENDLETON COUNTY FISCAL COURT ADOPTING COUNTY ROADS INTO THE COUNTY ROAD MAINTENANCE SYSTEM. ROADS THAT MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS AND HAVE FILED THE NECESSARY PETITION TO THE FISCAL COURT PER THE KRS 178.405) WHICH HAS ALLOWED THE FISCAL COURT TO TAKE SUCH ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, Ruth's Court, ~~Ashley Drive~~ Ashley Lane, being unmaintained roads that were created as part of a plotted subdivision know as Harold's Happy Homestead, and recorded on April 30, 1999 in the County Clerks Office, map #164, this being done prior to the county adopting subdivision regulations, in which these roads were never brought up to county specifications under KRS 178.010 (3), and

WHEREAS, Ruth's Court and ~~Ashley Drive~~ Ashley Lane were plotted and recorded to be dedicated as public use, and have been used by the general public openly since the subdivision and roadway were established, leaving the residents of these roads to endure the cost of maintenance and upkeep for years, not only for safe passage but to continue mail and garbage services, and

WHEREAS, the residents of the Ruth's Court and ~~Ashley Drive~~ Ashley Lane desire for the county to take over maintenance of said roads and have petitioned the county as outlined in (KRS 178.405) to do so.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Court has determined that the conditions of (KRS 178.405) have been satisfied including the required 30ft minimum width (R/W), and will make the addition of the aforementioned roads into the county road maintenance program for the roads to be maintained in the same manner as other county roads per (KRS 178.420).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Court of Pendleton County acknowledged they have received a Petition from the residents of Ruth's Ct. and ~~Ashley Dr.~~ Ashley Ln. and furthermore determines that the requirements have been met, and hereby thru this resolution officially approves the addition of the aforementioned roads to be place into the county road maintenance system for the 2020 calendar year.
