ORDINANCE NO. 830.1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 820.6 RELATED TO THE PENDLETON COUNTY
SOLID WASTE DISTRICT AND ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

Be it Ordained by the Fiscal Court of the County of Pendleton:

To amend Ordinance 820.6 to read as follows:

Pendleton County Solid Waste District shall be managed and operated by a board of directors to be appointed by the Pendleton County judge/Executive and confirmed by the Fiscal Court. Except for the initial appointment to the board, each director shall serve for a two year term; the board shall consist of **Five (5)** ~~Seven (7)~~ directors. Three (3) shall be appointed in odd years and **two (2)** ~~four (4)~~ in even years. Should a duly appointed director die, resign or refuse to act, an appointment may be made for the unexpired term.

Refusal to act shall be inferred by failure of a director to attend three consecutive regular meetings of the board.

Notwithstanding the number of active board members, has at the adoption of this ordinance, fallen below the five (5) members laid out in this Ordinance.

The Board shall elect a chairman, secretary and treasurer and shall operate under ~~a budget and uniform accounting system as required by law, including the filing and publishing an annual statement.]~~

the budget of the Pendleton County Fiscal Court.
